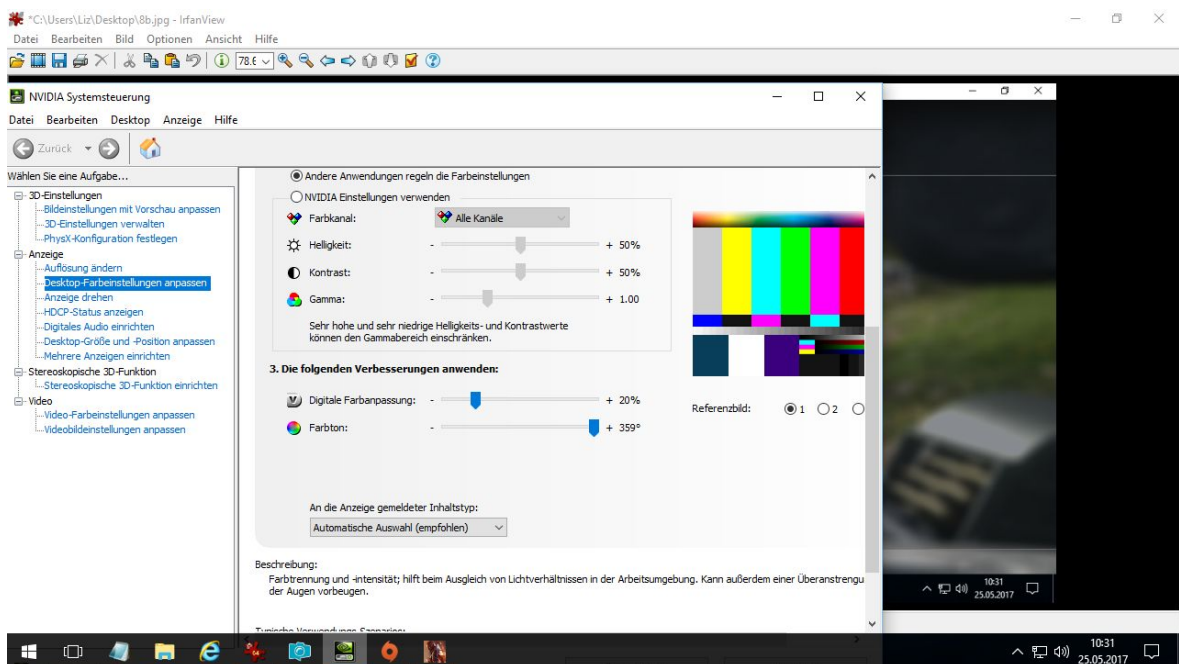


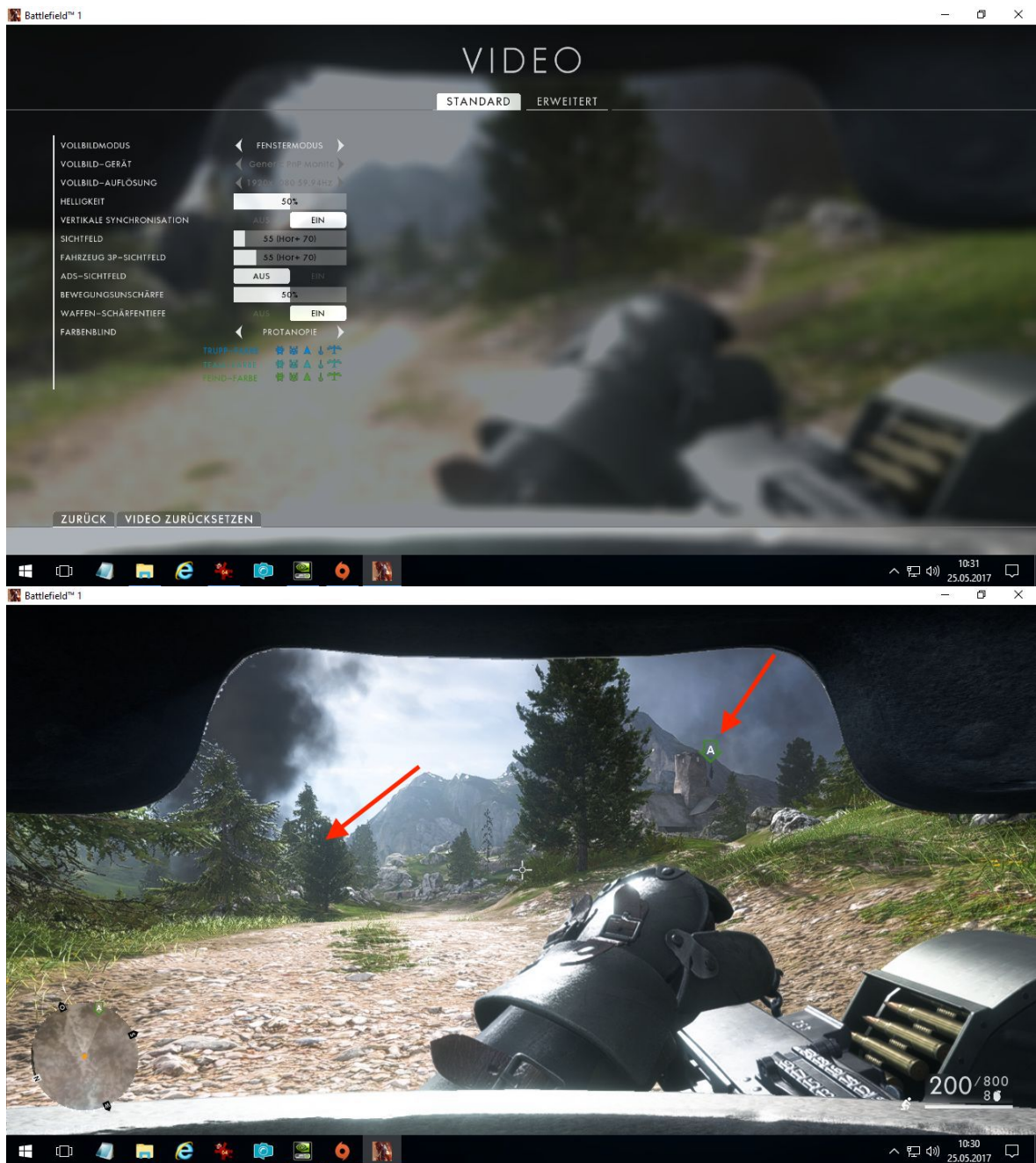
These are two filters they could be your favorites. The in game pictures look the first moment the same. But we use a **green-blue** contrasts with a matte color. Many of you have green blindness problems and therefore we mixed the color palettes.

Environment is more green, but the important objectives are clearly highlighted.

Look at the target and the small details that I marked. You notice trees are juicy green, but your target is clearly marked. This has the advantage that the enemy line already recognizes far enough.

Brightness also plays an important role. The eye retina is not so stressed in this mode

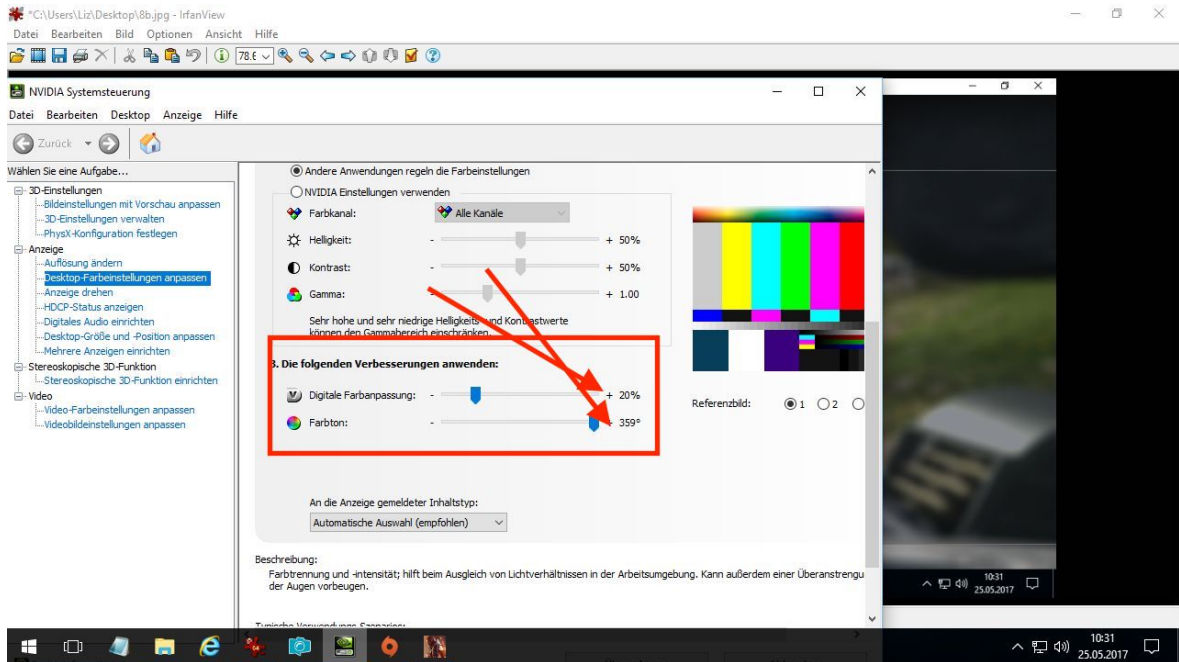




We put the same colorblind filter in BF1 and focus our eyes on blue. We switch to blue and you see that the edges of the picture and contrasts are somewhat dampened in the environment. The trees are no longer immersed in green, but your opponents are still visible.

We played in this mode for almost an hour and our eye was not overloaded.

How do I set this color contrast?
Push both slide balk fully to the right
